### Local League Will Send 2 Delegates To National Meet

Mrs. H. J. Liverance, newly re-elected president of the local organization, and Mrs. F. G. Garrison, re-elected vice-president, will represent the Birmingham League of Women Voters at the annual convention in Kansas City, Mo., April 30 to May 3.

Of the 500 delegates from 35 states, Michigan Leagues will send total of 19 delegates and alternates, including Mrs. Frank C. Haskins, retiring state president.

In general, this meeting to set the course of the organization for the next two years, will decide the best methods for the League to use to promote the participation of citizens in government. Specifically, they will decide how the League may help to strengthen United Nations, to strengthen the organization and support of the U. S. Congress, and what economic policies the League can support to insure maximum production and employment in the United States.

One "workshop" period will be given over to voters' service. Early in its history the League recognized that in a live democracy, voters must exercise their responsibilities in electing representatives. During the coming Congressional state and county primaries, the League will follow its precedent of informing voters of the mechanics of voting, and reminding them of registration and election dates. It will make available a candidates' report with their views on public questions.
