An ROTC student at the University of Cincinnati, Dooley was called to active duty in January, 1943, attended Ordnance Officers Candidate School at Aberdeen, Md., and was commissioned Second Lieutenant in April, 1943. Assigned to 512th Heavy Maintenance Co., he went overseas with that organization and saw action in the four campaigns of Northern France, Ardennes, Rhineland, and Central Germany. In addition to the European Theatre Ribbon with four stars, Lt. Dooley wears the American Theater and Victory Ribbons.

A native of Birmingham, Mich., Lieutenant Dooley attended high school in that city. He secured his BS in mechanical engineering from the University of Cincinnati in 1943. His wife, the former Martha Petry, is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. J. Petry, 3729 Applegate avenue, Cheviot, Ohio.

### Shifting Pavement To Save Trees On Willits Not Favored

In reply to a recent request from the City Commission for a study on the proposed paving on Willits street, from Woodward avenue to Bates street, in an effort to change the route and save some large shade trees, the city engineering department reports the plan is unworkable.

City Manager D. C. Egbert recently made the following report to the City Commission, covering the matter: "Gentlemen: "The Engineering Department has completed a study of the possibility of shifting the pavement off center on Willits Street in order that the trees on the south side of the street could be saved.

"Here Are Reasons: "The Engineering Department reports that this is not possible for the following reasons: "There is a difference in the grade between the sidewalk and the pavement amounting to 2.3 feet between the sidewalk and the pavement on the south side of Willits Street, near Bates. This difference in grade would require that the trees be ultimately removed at such time as building is constructed along the sidewalk on Willits and the grade of the building made to conform with the street grade.

"Shifting the pavement north would require that the front of the Bany building be altered due to the fact that in order to maintain a smooth curb line, the sidewalk in front of the Bany property would be narrowed to such an extent that it would not provide adequate sidewalk space."
