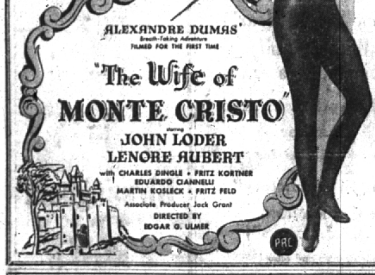

In the 1946 version of that old political maxim, "Throw Out the Rascals!" Michigan voters will have a choice of two climatic endings on Nov. 5.

First election of Kim Sigler, craft-busting crusader, who is the Republican nominee for Governor. Second, election of Murray D. Van Wagener, former governor, who made his reputation on better highways and who is now the Democratic nominee for Governor.

Each nominee is pledged to purify Lansing. That in itself is a coincidence which makes the forthcoming campaign of novel interest.

When it comes to throwing out the rascals, Sigler is no amateur. His money campaign was predicated on a pledge to get just that—clean up Lansing which he depicted as a sorry cesspool of iniquity. In fact, the state convention of the Republicans proceeded to adopt the slogan "Clean up Lansing" as Secretary of State Hermon Digan, Morrison and Attorney General John Dethmers. Only D. Hale Brake, state treasurer who backs the Michigan National bank interests in the legislature, was spared the Sigler's wrath.

Maguire Qualifies For PGA Tourney

Ray Maguire, of Birmingham Country Club, raised one of the five qualifying positions for the national P. G. A. tournament to be held in Portland, Oregon, August 19 to 26, by scoring his home course in even par five times for rounds of 72-72.

The qualifying rounds were played at Birmingham on July 22 and Bill Wright, of Lakepointe, was the only pro to shade par. He matched his morning round of 74 with a stabilizing afternoon of 69 to nip par by one stroke.

The five Michigan pros, along with 49 others from all over the United States, will make up the 64 who will start in the biggest of all P. G. A. events at Portland Harbor Lodge was open last summer.
