

### Vesper Players To Give W. H. Auden's "For the Time Being"

The Greek theater at Cranbrook is where W. H. Auden's "For the Time Being" will be staged August 25, 27, 28 and 29 by the Vesper players of Detroit. The curtain rises at 8:30 p. m. and on August 27 Birminghamites will be given special attention.

Included in the cast are Gertrude Rogerson who plays "Intuition," and James Packard who has the role of "Simeon." Both are from Birmingham.

The play deals with the greatest moral and spiritual crisis of all ages, and meets the problems of the world squarely. Time magazine has called it the most discussed drama in poetry of this generation. The producer is David U. Farlow, and the production director is John Everett Boyd.

"For the Time Being" is the first production staged by the Vesper Players, who plan to present contemporary, experimental works by living authors in the future. Creative lighting, a completely original music score by Diogenes Sewalk, the cast of 30, and unusual interpretations are featured in this month's presentation.

### COOK'S COUNCIL

**First-of-the-Harvest Favorites**  
This month the Apple Kasha Salad rates top billing. For not only does it stretch a skimpy main-course meal, but it doubles as dessert. It needs no apples as the main ingredient—the season's earliest beauties, flaunting their gypsy-eyes, are being the first to give white flesh to your knife in fat skins that have a juicy smack to them. The sweetening element is raisins—those honeyed-pellets nature has been sun-ripening all summer, until they have become a storehouse of delicate fruit sugars. Cheapest nuts contribute protein richness, while celery provides crisp crunch and a wonderfully earthy flavor.

**Waldorf Salad**  
Combine—  
1/2 cup seedless diced apple  
1/4 cup seedless nectars or seedless raisins  
1/2 cup minced nuts  
1/2 cup chopped nuts  
1/2 cup diced celery  
1/2 cup salad dressing.  
Let stand in refrigerator for one hour. Serve on lettuce leaves. Serve 8.

Another favorite is cole slaw. Not cole slaw as you often see it—slump shreds sinking hollow-chests in shallow sauces. This is a buoyant cole slaw heaped proudly in its own bold shell. A mammoth head is hollowed out. Its inner portion shredded fine, then mixed with chunks of apple and a lavish cup of mayonnaise. There now, is a flavor blend to command a country epicure's attention: cabbage's peppery bite, gentled by the raisin's simple sweetness, then recharged with apple's autumn tang. Make it so!

**Cabbage Salad Bowl**  
Cut top from  
1. head of cabbage leaving cabbage whole. Remove center from cabbage so that 3/4-inch shell remains. Shred the cabbage removed from center.  
2. Cut in wedges, removing core.  
3. Combine shredded cabbage, apple wedges, and raisins.  
4. cup seedless raisins.  
5. cup cooked salad dressing.  
6. 3 tablespoons milk.  
Pour over cabbage mixture. Toss lightly. Place in cabbage shell. Serves 6 to 8.
