We are happy to have had this opportunity to get behind a man who symbolizes the majority desire for clean and honest government.

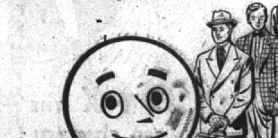
There is no doubt in our mind, but what Sigler will win the November election, becoming Michigan's next Governor, January 1, 1947.
