Conroy's first round was a three-under-par 69 and his second

round was a 74. Watrous was out in 71 and in with 73.

The tournament was a PGA sponsored event and thirty-five pros, mostly from the Detroit district, took part.

Speech Deficient Children Will Be Given Special Aid

Alice Worel, speech correctionist, who is obtaining her master's degree from the University of Michigan, has been appointed by the Birmingham Board of Education to study and correct the speech habits of children in the Birmingham school system.

Miss Worel's appointment Tuesday night came as a result of a survey in the spring of 1945 by E. W. Bilton, speech pathologist on the staff of Wayne University.

In his survey, Bilton discovered that more than 10 children in Birmingham had speech deficiencies. He recommended to Superintendent of Schools Dwight B. Ireland, that Birmingham obtain a speech correctionist.

Dr. Ireland contacted Dr. John S. Haitema, chief of the Special Education Division of the State Department of Education, who informed him that the State would pay most or all of the salary of such a correctionist from the Birmingham Board, he said, must buy the necessary equipment.

Therefore, the Board Tuesday night approved an expenditure of approximately \$600 for a recording device, a pure-tone tester, and other special equipment for use in Miss Worel's work.
