Many Veterans Get Assistance Through Red Cross Service

A monthly average of 630 veterans have been given service during the past four months by the two home service offices of the Oakland County Chapter, American Red Cross, according to Mrs. Noble, chairman of the home service committee of the chapter. Service to these veterans has been given by volunteers and home service staff members.

In anticipation of an increasing load in service to veterans, a group of fifteen volunteers have recently been given a basic home service training course and two staff members have received special training from the American National Red Cross.

Service given during the past four months has consisted of assistance with claims and reports; consultation and guidance; hospitalization and various other services. Besides service to veterans, the chapter has had a monthly average of 700 active servicemen during this same period. This service consisted of reports to Red Cross field directors; verification of the need for furloughs and extensions; health and welfare reports; consultation and guidance in family problems.

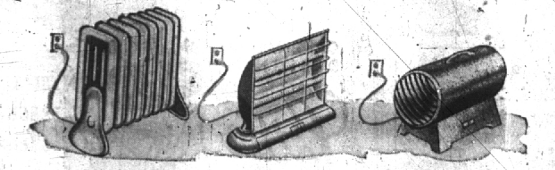
