**Gen. Reinhart Will Talk To Men's Club**

The Men's Club of St. James Episcopal church will have its second dinner meeting of the late winter at the church on March 25 at 8 p. m. with Brig. Gen. Stanley Reinhart, U. S. Army, as the speaker. The topic for his talk will be "Military Training and Citizenship."

General Reinhart is a West Point graduate and served in the field artillery in both World War I and World War II. During World War I he served in Europe and was promoted to captain and then to major. He was awarded five battle stars and the Distinguished Service Medal.

After the war he was graduated from the Army War College, Washington, D. C. and from command and general staff school. He served for three years on the general staff and was treasurer of the Military Academy for four years. During this time he served on the general staff and was commanding the field artillery of the 25th Division in the South Pacific war area.
