When an electric heater is used indiscriminately, abnormally high electric bills can result.

Here is a simple rule to follow in determining the amount of electricity a heater will use. Take the number of watts shown on the name plate divided by 1000 times 2 cents which will give you the minimum cost of operation per hour.



For example, the minimum cost of using a thousand-watt heater is equivalent to burning ten 100-watt bulbs or seventeen 60-watt bulbs. A 1000-watt heater costs 14c a week if used one hour daily for seven days. The same unit if used eight hours daily costs \$1.12 per week and \$4.80 per month.
