He asked John to play for him and then told him that he was to be the principal bass of one of the larger orchestras this coming season and said he wanted John to come there at an increase over what he received the past season in Dallas.

The next morning a contract came from another of the larger West coast orchestras with still larger offer, transportation both ways, extra money for broadcasts and other supplementary engagement.

ORDINANCE NUMBER 227 GAS BURNER EQUIPMENT CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

An Ordinance to Regulate the Installation and Use of Gas Burner Equipment Used in Connection with Heating Systems in the City of Birmingham.

The City of Birmingham Ordinance No. 227, Gas Burner Equipment, shall issue a permit for installing any gas burner approved by the American Gas Association or any other nationally recognized inspection board or laboratory. Gas burners not approved by the American Gas Association or any other nationally recognized inspection board or laboratory shall not be installed until they have been inspected and approved by some recognized engineering board or laboratory capable of making such a test and inspection.

The permit fee shall be Three Dollars for each residence, or industrial installation plus fifty cents for each additional unit.

through which fine gases are conducted shall be thoroughly cleaned and examined for leaks and draft conditions before installation is to be made.

Sec. 12—Support of Location. Fine pipe shall be well supported to prevent sagging, shall be adequately insulated from and no gas shall be heated closer than four inches to combustible building materials.

Sec. 13—Safety Devices. The boiler or furnace shall be equipped with safety devices, including a high water cut-off, and shall be equipped with a pressure regulator.

Sec. 14—Ventilation. Gas burners, as articles specified shall not be installed in an appliance located in a room where the normal facilities for ventilation do not permit proper combustion of the gas.
