First Lease Lend Started In Detroit Way Back In 1796

EDITOR'S NOTE: This is the second of a series dealing with myths and inaccuracies in Michigan history...

British troops did not destroy public property before evacuating Detroit in 1796, according to C. Clever Bald, war historian of the University of Michigan...

Bald indicates the incorrect version of the British evacuation in accordance with the terms of Jay's Treaty first was published in 1858...

One historian wrote that Detroit was vacated by the British after the wells had been filled with stones, windows broken and the gates of the fort locked.

General Wayne, commander of American troops taking over the fort, reported it had been surrendered in "the most polite, friendly and accommodating manner."

When, in addition to quick germination, a flower has large seed and colorful blossoms, it is bound to be widely grown and popular...

Among these are the following annuals, which should germinate in 5 days: Ageratum, amaranth, aster, gladiolus, carnation, geranium, petunia, zinnia...

These small seeded, slow germinators are as easy to grow as the fast ones if they are started in a seed box. Success, in fact, is even surer, because of reduced hazards...

Perennial germinators include acrocalymma, pimpernel, anemone, anemone, aster, balsam, brachycome, calendula, carnation, cerastium, cleome, columbine, dianthus, morpheus, California poppy, gypsophila, lobelia, lupin, poppy, pyrethrum, portulaca, scabiosa, thionia.

Varieties which take from 15 to 20 days to show growth include begonia, datura, annual larkspur, godetia, impatiens, kochia, primula, malva, salpiglossis, sweet peas...

It will be a good one to keep.

Datura (French Lily) needs fifteen to twenty days.
