Dr. Johanna J. Van Dulleman, European educator and Soroptimist, will be the guest speaker to be presented by the R. O. Soroptimist Club Friday evening, Dec. 6, at 8 p. m. in the Royal Oak High School.

The Royal Oak Soroptimists have extended an invitation to the Birmingham Soroptimists, all men's and women's service groups, church and teacher groups, PTAs, social welfare and civic organizations, character education groups, senior students, and all other organizations especially interested in progressive education as a means of developing an international understanding for the promotion of world peace, to be guests of their organization that evening.

Dr. Van Dulleman, whose topic for the evening will be "Postwar Trends in European Education," studied at Groningen, Amsterdam and Oxford Universities, specializing in English, and obtained her Doctor's degree in England in 1924.

She has taught at the boys' grammar school in Rotterdam, and was headmistress at a girls' secondary school in Holland. She has studied progressive education both in America and in pre-war Germany, and wrote and gave many courses for university extension courses on both education and literary subjects.

She has served as founder and first president of the Women's Voluntary Service in Rotterdam, was on the board for the University Women's Educational Fund in Holland, and was on the International Board of the Soroptimist Union.

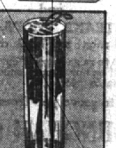

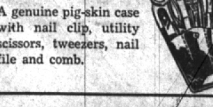
