"The rate is five cents to United States territory wherever located. Something to sell! Then try Eccentric Want Ads."

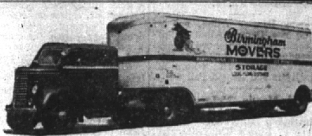
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## DSC Posthumously Given to Former Birmingham Youth

Mr. and Mrs. Bernard L. Snyder, Interlaken, North Muskegon, have received information from the commanding general, Fifth Army, that their son, Private Thomas H. Snyder, has been awarded posthumously the Distinguished Service Cross for extraordinary heroism in Germany.

The Snyder family were formerly residents of Birmingham, moving to Muskegon in 1937.

The citation accompanying the award stated that Snyder "voluntarily accompanied his commanding officer on a mission to take and secure the only remaining intact bridge over the Dortmund-Ems Canal, Scherpenseel, Germany, vitally important for the unhampered advance of the United States Airborne troops and British army."

Private Snyder was killed in action on January 19, 1945, while serving with the 82nd Airborne Division, 1st Infantry Division, 1st Airborne Division, 1st Airborne Division, 1st Airborne Division.

When his commanding officer was wounded, Snyder, "realizing the importance of the task, disregarded the heavy enemy fire, advanced alone across the bridge to reach the demolition charge. In the course of this action he was hit and mortally wounded. Private Snyder's loyalty, sacrifice and heroic achievement reflect the highest credit upon himself and the armed forces of the United States."

Private Snyder is buried in an American cemetery near Maastricht, Holland. He entered service in January, 1942, sailed for England in July, 1944, where he was trained as a paratrooper, and crossed to France in December, joining the 2nd Airborne Division during the "Battle of the Bulge."

His brother, Bernard Snyder, Jr., is an ensign in the Submarine service.
