Children at Adams School have been busy preparing displays, completing projects and readying their class rooms for the night when their parents will come to the school, see their work and talk with their teachers.

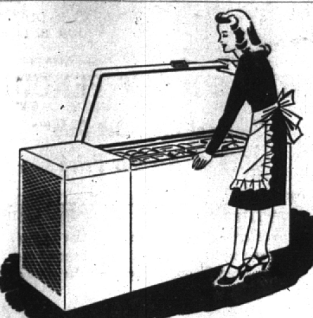

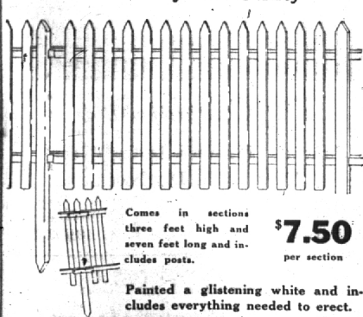

## Community House To Welcome Newcomers To Birmingham

The Community House will open its doors wide and extend a sincere welcome to all newcomers of Birmingham at a reception to be held from 8 to 10 p. m. on Wednesday, Nov. 13.

For eight years the board of directors has acted as hosts and hostesses at the reception to acquaint newcomers with the facilities of the house and to have them meet representatives of various local organizations.

Mrs. Hugh D. McLessee, chairman of the social committee of the house, is in charge of the affair, and Mrs. F. H. McKinney of the Garden Club is handling table decorations.

Invitations have been sent to 252 new arrivals in town and the presidents of 43 civic and social organizations have been invited, as well as city officials, the school board, ministers from all the churches, past presidents and the board of directors of the Community House.

**ORDINANCE NO. 335**  
AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 11 (B) of Ordinance No. 333, adopted October 21, 1946, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the acquisition and construction of additions, extensions and improvements to the Water Supply System of the City of Birmingham by the acquisition and construction of new wells and connecting mains and certain portions of the same, and providing for the issuance of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System and the payment of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System on such revenues and providing for the redemption of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System and the payment of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System." The City of Birmingham Ordains:

Section 11 (B) of Ordinance No. 333, adopted October 21, 1946, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the acquisition and construction of additions, extensions and improvements to the Water Supply System of the City of Birmingham by the acquisition and construction of new wells and connecting mains and certain portions of the same, and providing for the issuance of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System and the payment of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System on such revenues and providing for the redemption of said bonds out of the revenues of said Water Supply System." is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11 (B) Bond and Interest Redemption Fund: There shall next be established and maintained a Bond and Interest Redemption Fund, which shall be used solely and only for the purpose of paying the principal of and interest on the Revenue Bonds authorized. Out of the revenues of the City of Birmingham, there shall be set apart and paid into the Bond and Interest Redemption Fund at the beginning of each quarter commencing with April 1, 1947, there shall be set apart and paid into said Bond and Interest Redemption Fund a sum equal to one-half (1/2) of the interest next falling due on the bonds herein authorized and one-fourth (1/4) of the principal of the bonds next falling due. The sum shall also be set apart and paid into the Bond and Interest Redemption Fund, each quarter, a further sum equal to ten per cent (10%) of the regular quarterly payment above required until a reserve has been accumulated equal to the maximum principal and interest becoming due in any succeeding operating year. Such reserve shall be held in the Bond and Interest Redemption Fund and used solely for the payment of principal and interest on said bonds if current revenues are insufficient to provide therefor. However, that no further payments need be made into said fund after enough of the bonds have been retired so that the amount then held in said fund (including such reserve) is equal to the entire amount of principal and interest which will be payable at the time of the maturity of all the bonds then remaining outstanding. If, in any operating or fiscal year, the City shall fail to pay into the Bond and Interest Redemption Fund the full amount heretofore stipulated, then an amount equivalent to such deficiency shall be set apart and paid into said fund from the first available revenue of the following fiscal year or years.

This ordinance shall be published in full in the Birmingham Post-Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Birmingham, qualified under State law to publish legal notices, within one week of its adoption.

**Section 11.**  
This ordinance declared to be effective immediately upon its adoption, to-wit: November 7, 1946.

Thence S 24° 18' 30" E 493.25 feet along the west line of Woodward Avenue.

Thence S 87° 58' 30" W 147.43 feet to the east line of lots 44 to 59 inclusive of the Quarters Lake Estates Subdivision of East Part of Quarters Lake Estates.

Thence S 1° 05' 30" E 494.00 feet along said east line to the southwest corner of lot 11.

Thence N 28° 24' 30" E 433.95 feet along the south line of lot 1, 47 to 11 inclusive of the same subdivision to the point of beginning, from the present classification of Multiple-Family Residence District to RESIDENTIAL ATTACHED RESIDENCE DISTRICT.
