

Sunday Carillon Recital Program is Announced

The vesper services and carillon recitals at Christ Church Cranbrook will continue this Sunday at 4:30 p. m. with the second in the fall series. August Masketbergher will again give the carillon recital which will be followed by an organ recital in the Church by Ellwood W. Hill assisted by William Casey flutist, beginning at approximately 5 p. m.

The series began last Sunday with a beautiful day encouraging a large and enthusiastic audience to attend. The services will be continued throughout the months of October, November, and December. Such special programs will be

presented as the Russian Choir from the Cathedral of St. Peter and St. Paul, November 17, the oratorio Verdi's "Requiem," and Handel's "Messiah" November 19 and December 22, by the Christ Church Cranbrook Choir. During the month of October carillon recitals will be given during the first half-hour of the vespers.

The carillon program for this Sunday afternoon will include Menotti's "Prelude," "Drink To Me Only With Thine Eyes," "O, Soldier, Soldier, Won't You Marry Me?" "Old Folks at Home," "There Is Music in the Air," "Flocio's "Aria," and the hymn "Faith of Our Fathers."

The organ recital will be completely given over to Handel and consists of the following works: "Organ Prelude," "Meditation," "Concerto for Organ," "Sonata" (flute and organ), and "Water Music," in three movements.

Methodist Church Will Celebrate 125th Anniversary

In honor of the 125th anniversary of Methodism in Birmingham a program of visiting pastors, including Dr. William W. Whitehouse, president of Albion College; dinners and recitals has been announced by the 125th Anniversary committee of the First Methodist church.

The occasion is in honor of an itinerant Methodist circuit rider who conducted the first church service here in 1821. The service marked the beginning of 125 years of Methodism here. The first Methodist church was built in 1839 and the present structure in 1872.

Dr. Joseph Dutton, pastor of the church from 1919 to 1922, will preach at the morning "Homecoming Service" Sunday, Nov. 17. In the evening a unique vesper-fellowship service will feature Eddie Edwards as organist and the Rev. Robert Richards as song leader and soloist. Refreshments will be served by the WBSJ following the service.

Former Pastors to Appear
The anniversary banquet will be held Thursday evening, Nov. 21, in the dining room of the Baptist church. Three hundred fifty people are anticipated at this dinner. Former members of the church will appear on the program following.

The week's activities will end Sunday, Nov. 24, when Dr. William W. Whitehouse, close friend of the Birmingham church, will deliver the final sermon at the 11 a. m. service.

One of the principal features of the anniversary program is a booklet, now being prepared by Mrs. Carl Binkie, which will give a complete history of the church. Various photos of interest and a roster of church members will also be included.
