Vandenberg Says US, Russia Can Agree—But Soviets Aren't Making It Easy

Russia will consider it "had news" that Arthur H. Vandenberg, Secretary of State James Byrnes at the Paris peace talks.

For months the Michigan senator has been attacked again and again in the Russian press, so much so that he has come to be regarded by Soviet leaders as "Enemy No. 1."

No matter how many times Senator Vandenberg states his contention that this country and Soviet Russia can get along . . . and he even gave the Russians a formula the Russians continue their criticism.

The Senator has been critical of Russian truculence shown in a long series of incidents in Europe and Asia.

Back in September

Before he left, Senator Vandenberg made his personal plans very clear. He will return for the opening of the General Assembly of the United Nations in New York on September 23rd. Openly he has opposed any postponement of that, which is another reason why the Russians don't love him.

He will not participate further in the 1946 political campaign in Michigan in which he is up for re-election. For the first time in his career he will be a candidate for re-election "in absentia."

Just before he departed he said that while he was engaged in representing this country, either as an adviser to the Secretary of State in Europe or as a delegate to the United Nations, he would not lift his voice in partisan party politics.

Aids U. S. Policy

One thing is admitted here in Washington concerning Vandenberg's role in international meetings. He has aided and abetted in the formulation of a stiffer policy towards Russia's aggressive actions.

Meanwhile the junior senator, Homer Ferguson, is out of the country too and will not be back until September 10. He's busy in Central America on a special investigation for the Mead Committee on expenditures involved in the building of the Inter-American highway.

Michigan, in the Fifth Army Area, is no exception. Orders have been received to cut civilian payrolls from 18,328 to 13,967. So after October 1, 4,361 employees, now on Army posts, in Army hospitals, airfields and arsenals will be looking for jobs.

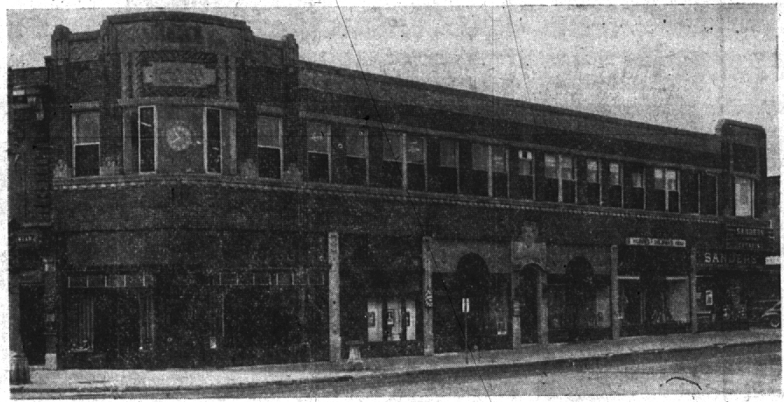
The reduction will affect nine Michigan installations.

Fort Custer, Fort Wayne, the Detroit Tank Arsenal at Center Line, Percy Jones General Hospital, Selfridge Field, and four Army airfields, Kinross, Orsedo, Race Airfield, and Willow Run, all inactive, but not yet declared excess.

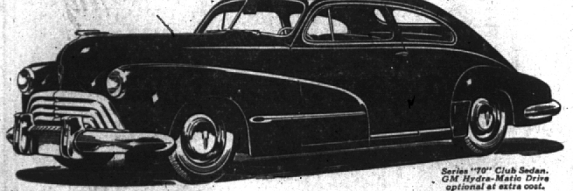
