#### Mail Route Extensions OK'd

November 27 issue. The letter, briefly, asked why it had taken four months for Washington to approve the extensions, and asked Dondero to discuss the matter with postal officials.)

The pertinent portions of the Postmaster General's letter to Dondero follow:

"The postmaster of Birmingham has been authorized to adjust the city routes to place them on a seven hour and forty-five minute basis and to establish an auxiliary route for the purpose of making extensions and relieving the overburdened routes.

"When these changes have been placed into effect, it is believed there will be no further cause for complaint of the delivery service.

"In connection with the investigation made of the carrier needs of the Birmingham office, the inspector also made an investigation of the clerical needs. The information furnished by him failed to disclose the need for additional clerical positions."

With the Christmas post office rush merely hours away. The Eccentric at this time has no intention of possibly disrupting local postal service by delving further into the possibility that extra clerks may be needed at the Birmingham office. Anyone visiting the post office between now and Christmas Eve, at first glance would say that many, many more clerks could be basily engaged full time. That is to be expected at this time of year.

When the local office gets back on its feet and out from under the Yuletide load, which will be shortly after the first of the year, the local office will be hetter able to evaluate its regular requirements and whether additional facilities should be requested from Washington.

That would be the proper time to continue our studies.
