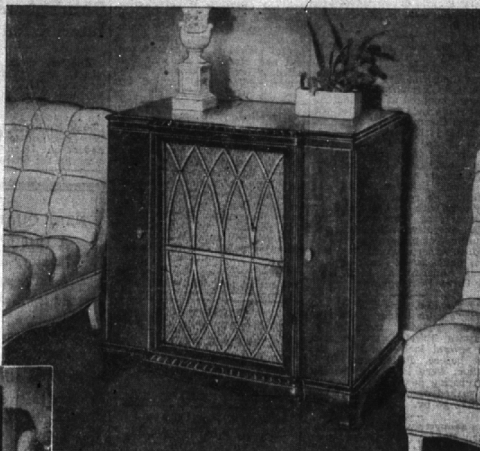

Peace Plate:

FLAKED FISH PIE

1 1/2 cups flaked fish 1 small can vegetable soup
2 tablespoons butter 3 cups hot, mashed potatoes
3 tablespoons flour 1/2 teaspoon salt

PEAT CRISP

4 fresh pears 4 tablespoons sugar
1/2 cup fine, dry bread crumbs 4 tablespoons margarine
1 tablespoon lemon juice

Peace Plate:

It is easy to omit eggs from your menu on Thursday if you start the day with a nutritious hot cooked cereal generously fortified with raisins or other fruit.

VEAL IN SOUR CREAM

2 tablespoons flour 1 clove garlic
2 teaspoons salt 1 1/2 cups chopped onions
1/2 teaspoon pepper 1 cup sour cream
1 1/2 lbs. veal, cut in inch cubes 1 package (10 oz.) cooked noodles

MINCEMEAT BARS

1 1/4 cups all-purpose flour 1 cup quick-cooking oatmeal
3/4 cup brown sugar 1/2 cup shortening
1/2 teaspoon salt 1/2 cups moist mincemeat

Sift flour, measure, add oatmeal, brown sugar and salt; mix well. Cut the crumb mixture evenly over bottom of greased 6x8-inch pan.
