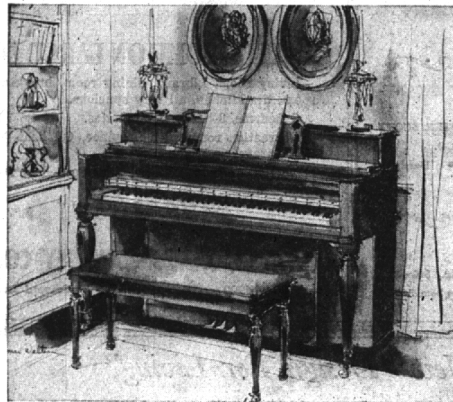

## Delegates Give Convention Report to Local Realtors

Thirty-five members of the Birmingham Real Estate Board held their November meeting at the Community House last week. High point of the program was Clyde Bennett's report of topics discussed at the San Francisco Convention of the National Real Estate Association.

Mrs. L. E. Holton, another delegate to the Convention, said that the 40th Annual Meeting of the national group was the most worthwhile of any she had had the pleasure of attending.

Merrill Adams of the Birmingham National Bank, briefly discussed "The Cost of Money" in respect to real estate and residential home financing. He stated present rates of mortgage interest were at an extremely advantageous low figure for the borrower. He reminded brokers of the high interest rates charged during the 20's and for the premium costs of procuring mortgage funds.

W. W. Raymond was complimented by Board President Ferd Brook for his fine work with the Conservation Department in getting Dodge Park on the 13 1/2 Mile Road deeded to Southfield Township instead of being liquidated to private ownership. Raymond said he felt the park should be preserved as a necessary community center for the rapidly growing Beverly Hills section.
