Canteen business meetings are held on the first and third Tuesday each month, at which time the youth plan programs, discuss problems relative to the Canteen and iron out the mazes so that the Ranch Room will be a place which the teen-agers will enjoy.

The program committee have prepared an extensive list of activities for next year, which will include dances, outdoor activities and sports events.

For the big birthday celebration tomorrow, when they celebrate a year of operation, the whole Community House will be open to the youth. A dance in the auditorium, bridge and table games, singing around the piano, ping pong, pool and shuffleboard are only a few of the entertainments to be offered.
