The girls have obtained permission from Holy Name School to use the Alumnae House and playground to take care of local youngsters while their mothers are untown shopping.

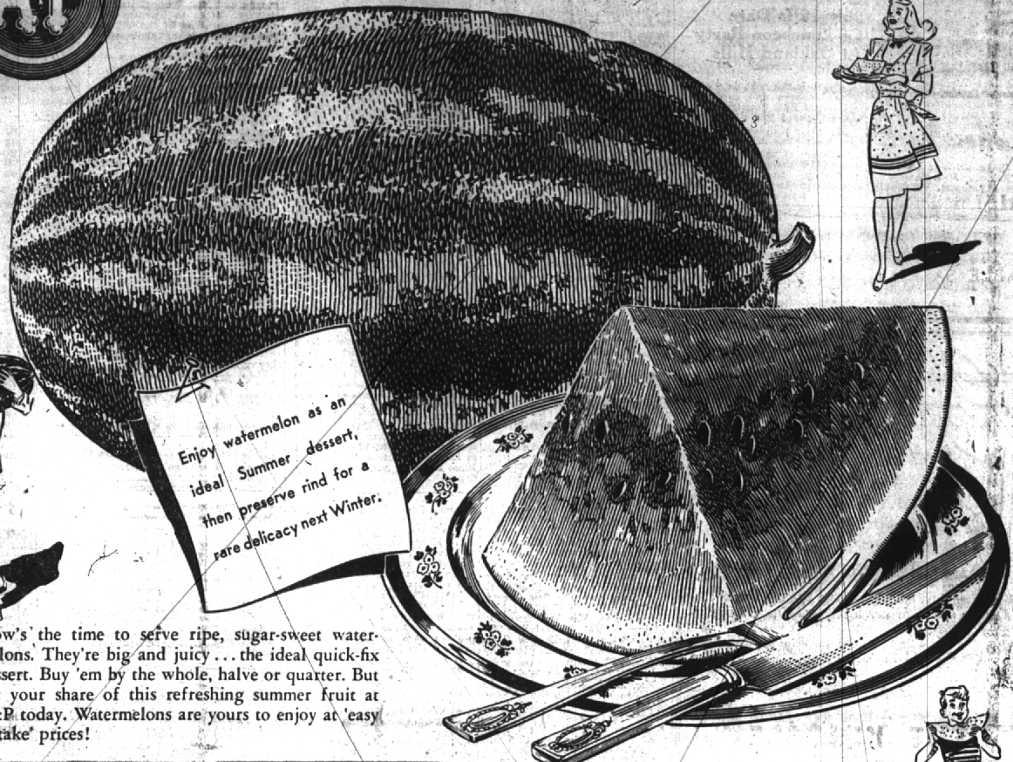
Their baby park for children will continue until August 15, and will be open each day from 2 p.m. to 5 p.m.
