Clarence W. Lusk, deputy revenue commissioner, predicts that an amendment to the sales tax law may save Michigan farmers and owners of farms \$1,500,000 to \$2,000,000 a year. New exemptions for the good of the state would be legislated on purchases by persons "having an interest in tilling of soil or raising of livestock and poultry" for such things as clothing, household appliances, and other products. Buyers must sign statements as to intended use.


