

**'M' Summer Course Plans Series of Four Lectures**

Internationally known men will discuss world affairs in a series of four lectures beginning July 17 at the Rackham Educational Memorial. The lectures, which are open to the public without charge, are being sponsored by the University of Michigan's Extension Service and Summer Session.

They will be given at 8 p. m. on consecutive Thursday evenings in the small auditorium of the Rackham Memorial, 100 Farnsworth. Speakers are regular guest faculty members of the University's Summer Session.

A discussion of "The Foreign Policy of the United States" by Dr. Lawrence Pressat will open the series on July 17. Dr. Pressat, who is professor of political science at the University, was with the Department of State during the war, serving in various capacities in the Division of International Organization affairs.

He was also in London as adviser to the American representative on the United Nations War Crimes Commission; was assistant secretary at the Dumbarton Oaks Conversations; was principal secretary of the United Nations Committee of Jurists; and was technical expert to the American delegation at the San Francisco Conference.

"The problem of International Understanding and the Organization of UNESCO" will be discussed on July 24 by Dr. Gottfried S. Delator, visiting professor of sociology, Columbia University, and former professor of sociology and political science, University of Frankfurt.

Third lecture in the series will be given by Dr. Robin A. Humphreys on "Democracy and Dictatorship in Latin America." Dr. Humphreys is Reader in American History in the University of London.

Dr. Yuen-li Liang will speak on August 7 on "The United Nations and its Role in the Settlement of International Disputes." He is director of the Division of the Development and Codification of International Law, United Nations.
