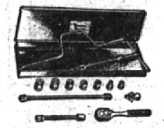

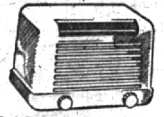

## City Commended For No Traffic Deaths in 1946

Commendation for Birmingham's record of no pedestrian deaths during 1946 from the American Automobile Association has been received by Mayor Ralph A. Main. Two other cities, similarly honored were Marquette and Holland.

Recognition of the city's record in the AAA National Pedestrian Protection Contest was contained in a letter to Mayor Main from H. J. Brunner, AAA president.

In commenting on the commendation, Ernest P. Davis, safety and traffic director of the Automobile Club of Michigan, attributed the perfect pedestrian record to "the outstanding cooperation between civic organizations, public officials, schools and the police department in combating the traffic accident problem."

Splendid 1946 Record  
The text of Brunner's letter to Mayor Main:

"It is a real pleasure to advise you that the Board of Judges of the 1946 AAA National Pedestrian Protection Contest unanimously voted that this letter of special recognition be sent to you as chief executive of Birmingham for its splendid record of no pedestrian deaths during 1946.

"The American Automobile Association also extends its sincere congratulations for your outstanding record.

It is our sincere hope that during 1947 your city will continue its perfect pedestrian fatality record and step up its pedestrian protection program so as to reduce to a minimum or eliminate entirely injury accidents involving the main street."

"Our staff will be pleased to continue to work with J. P. Hackett, chief of police, who acted so effectively as your 'contact man' in 1946."

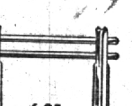

## Veteran Trainees Injured at Work Given Compensation

Birmingham veterans drawing compensation for service-connected disabilities who wish to enter a job-training program should know that under Public Law 16, any injuries incurred during the training program which result in further disabilities, or death, will result in benefits on the same basis as if the disability or death had been incurred in war service. These benefits do not apply to trainees under Public Law 346, Chapter 381, American Law of Veterans, states:

"If a veteran trainee suffers an injury, or aggravation of an injury, as a result of the pursuit of a course of vocational rehabilitation (P. L. 16), and not as the re-

sult of his own willful misconduct and such injury or aggravation results in additional disability to death of such person, benefits shall be awarded on the same basis as if the disability, aggravation, death had been incurred in war service. Application for this benefit must be made within two years after the injury was suffered such death occurred."
