STATE OF MICHIGAN - ORDER OF THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION - FISHING REGULATIONS IN PONTIAC LAKE, OAKLAND COUNTY. By authority of Act 239, P. A. 1925, as amended, the Conservation Commission hereby orders that for a period of five years from March 15, 1946, it shall be lawful to fish in the waters of Pontiac Lake situated in Township 2 North, Range 1 East, and in the waters of Waterford Township, Oakland County, at any time, for any species of fish on which the season is not closed.
