AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance No. 184, entitled "Building Code" (Sections 226(a), 430(a) and 431(a)) of said Ordinance.

The City of Birmingham Ordinance: That Sections 226(a), 430(a) and 431(a) of Ordinance No. 184, entitled hereby amended to read as follows:

430(a) Type VI Unprotected Metal Construction is that in which the inward bracing is by an unprotected metal frame, and the exterior walls are vertical, are at least 18 feet in

height, and are of masonry or other incombustible material having a fire resistance rating equal to 3 inches of masonry.

431(a) Within the Fire Limits District every building hereafter erected shall be one of the following types of construction:

Type I Fire-resistive Construction
 Type II Semi-Fire-resistive Construction
 Type III Mill or Store-keeping Construction
 Type IV Protected Ordinary Masonry Construction

Good Soil Needed for Home Gardens, MSC Expert Says

First ingredient of a successful home garden is good soil, Birmingham gardeners were advised this week by E. D. Longnecker, state specialist of the Michigan State College extension service, who added that poor garden soils can often be built up so that better crops are produced.

"The ideal garden soil is loose, granular and spongy. Water and air can penetrate to the roots easily in this type of soil. Home garden soil, however, is often sandy or heavy and tight and hard to work," he said.

A few basic materials will help to improve poor garden soils. Longnecker lists: manure, compost, sewage sludge, fertilizer, and in some cases, lime.

Liberal supplies of manure will improve manure soils. The manure should be spaded or plowed under if it is fresh and contains many weeds.

May Need Fertilizers

Compost can be supplied by turning under the sod. Big clumps of sod and heavy vegetation should be broken up and then spaded under. A compost pile started this way will supply future needs," he pointed out.

Lime counteracts the effect of soil acids and furnishes the calcium and magnesium needed by plants. Longnecker warns that soils should not be limed unless a soil test shows a definite need.

"Chemical fertilizers are needed unless the soil has been built up with lots of manure. Tests show that fertilizer is most effective when it is placed in bands 2 inches on either side of the row and slightly below the seed. Fertilizer may also be broadcast over the surface at the rate of 25 pounds per 1000 square feet and then worked into the surface layer," Longnecker explained.

Fertilizer analyses, such as 4-12-8, 3-12-12, 4-12-4, and 9-12-6 should prove satisfactory for the home garden, he said.

Buy Healthy Plants for Your Garden, Says County Agent

If you're planning to buy vegetable plants for your garden this year, you should be looking for healthy vigorous plants.

Okland County agricultural agent Karl D. Bailey says that there are three rules to follow when buying plants for the garden. First, buy plants that are strong and well rooted. Second, select plants that are free from disease. Third, purchase varieties adapted to growing conditions in your locality.
