Local SCF to Get Report on Europe From Dr. C. Joy

The Birmingham branch of the Save the Children Federation will hold a luncheon on Nov. 19 honoring Dr. Charles R. Joy, associate executive director of the national board, who has just returned from making a survey of the adopted schools in Europe.

Mrs. Angus McJay is general chairman of the affair which will be held in the Community House. She will be assisted by Mrs. William S. Howell, Mrs. W. L. Rose, Mrs. Philip Henderson, Mrs. Russell Barnes, Mrs. Albert Reibling and Mrs. Rudolph E. Each, who will be in charge of tickets. This is a subscription luncheon, and reservations should be made through Mrs. Each at the earliest possible date.

Invitations have been issued to all local organizations which have adopted schools this year, and to those who have assisted the SCF in its work.

Adopt French Schools

The schools which have been adopted by Birmingham are: Ecole de France, located in France, and include: Ecole de Bewey-sur Saulx, Meuse; Ecole de Filles de Chartres de Bretagne, Chartres de Bretagne; Ecole de Garçons de Chantillon en Vendéais, Chantillon en Vendéais; Ecole Publique de Garçons, Dinard; Ecole de Garçons, Leflavre; Ecole de Filles de Dinard, Dinard; Ecole de Garçons, Dannamarie; Ecole de Filles, Dannamarie; Ecole de Frauenberg, Frauenberg; Ecole de St. Laurent du Var, Alpes-Maritimes; Ecole Maternelle, Hellenemus, Les Lles (nord); Schools in the Netherlands and Finland are also being sponsored by private donors.

Dr. Joy will tell of the conditions of these schools and the progress which has been made through the support of the Birmingham group, and the United States as a whole.

Describes Children's Needs

Mrs. Each has recently received a letter from Ruth E. Freeman of the Adams school, telling of their experience with an adopted school. The letter reads:

"Last fall the student council of Adams school sent \$150 to the Save the Children Federation in New York. Upon receipt of the check the Federation sent us the name of a school for our personal contact. It is located in Vendell (Alsine), France.

"To date we have written 14 letters to the children and have had answers from them. We have had personal contacts with 10 children. The director of the school, M. de Lauenoux, has written us two letters telling us of the conditions and needs of the children.

"The Federation sent shoes and vitamin candies to the school with the \$150, which we sent to them. We have had letters of gratitude and deep appreciation for this wonderful experience.

"Nine boxes of toilet articles and school supplies have been sent to the children from all the rooms in Adams school. The children brought the articles, packed, weighed and wrapped them for mailing. Some of them walked to the office and had the experience of mailing these to their new friends.

"As an outgrowth of this development, the third grade has been learning French words (book, chair, door, good-bye, good morning, etc.).

"The children of Adams school feel helpful and happy in having a chance to take care of someone their own age who is less fortunate than they. We feel it is a wonderful experience for all concerned."

ORDINANCE NUMBER 355
CITY OF BIRMINGHAM

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 317 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM ENTITLED GAS BURNER EQUIPMENT BY AMENDING SECTION 44 THEREOF.

THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM ORDINANCES:

That Section No. 44 of Ordinance No. 317 entitled Gas Burner Equipment, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 44. Piping, Fuel Line or Burner. All gas piping installed for the service of the gas burners shall be of adequate size to supply the requirements of the heating system, and shall be of sufficient size to deliver gas to the burner at a pressure in excess of the manifold pressure specified by the burner manufacturer. No such piping or fuel line shall be constructed of any metal material having a melting point less than 1500 degrees Fahrenheit and no metal or material having a melting point less than the pipe itself shall be used to slip joints or connections of said pipe.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication after the same shall have been approved by the Commission of the City of Birmingham this 7th day of October, A. D. 1947.
