TREATMENT FOR CANINE DISTEMPER

The treatment of distemper is more difficult than most diseases due to the complex nature of the disease. So, in order for treatment to be effective, prompt action must be taken to insure success. Don't try to diagnose distemper.

Take your dog to a qualified veterinarian who will not only make a proper diagnosis but who is able to determine at which stage of the disease the animal is and who will institute the proper treatment.

In "virus distemper", the prompt use of immune serum will quite often dispel the attack promptly and prevent further complications.

The most important fact to remember is that in such a complex disease, treatment is difficult due to the complexity, and in order to give the animal a fair chance of regaining its health, treatment must be started early. Don't allow the dog to mope around the house three or four days before taking him to the veterinarian. If your dog becomes droopy and refuses food even for one day, find out immediately what the trouble is.

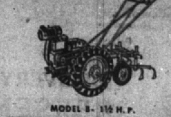

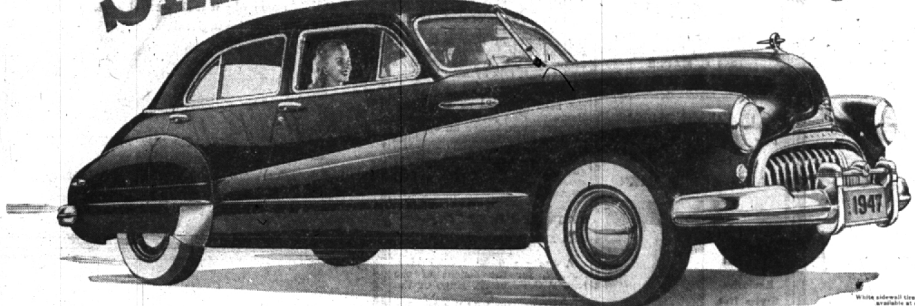
