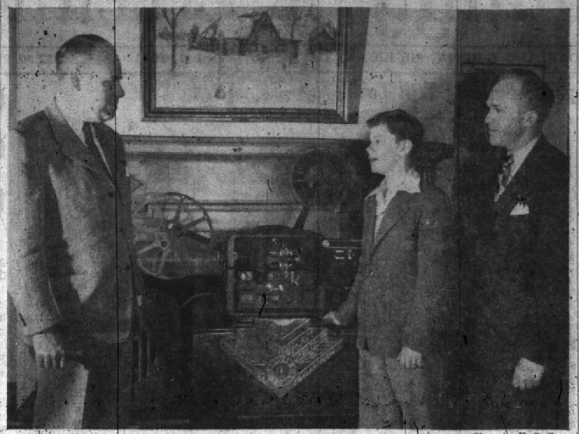

Community House Places 2,100 Applicants for Jobs Thru Employment Bureau

Well trained domestics, like housewives, remain in short supply, Mrs. Charlton reports. Good ones are as scarce as eves and will probably remain so until systematic training programs for house workers are established, she thinks.

Where They Work Three quarters of the permanent employment office are made in Birmingham, 117 records show.

Before she came to the local employment office last September Mrs. Charlton, who has long resided in Birmingham, worked at the U. S. Service Center in Detroit for more than a year.
