### Bishop to Be Guest of St. James Church at Sunday Services

Rev. Richard S. Enrich, seventh Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Michigan will make his annual visitation to St. James Church this Sunday. A class will be presented for confirmation at the regular 11 o'clock service, at which the bishop will preach. Rev. Enrich was born in Turkey where his parents were serving as missionaries. He studied at Phillips Academy, Andover, Mass., and was graduated from Bryn Mawr University in 1932. He then studied for a year at the Episcopal Seminary in New York, receiving his bachelor of divinity degree in 1935 and receiving a fellowship to Marlburg, Germany. He returned to this country in 1937, after receiving his doctorate in philosophy and served first at St. John's Church in Waterbury, Conn. In 1940 he was elected Suffragan Bishop of the Diocese of Michigan and began his work in September of that year. He was placed in charge of missionary work and the department of publicity. Under his leadership the diocese has expanded steadily, and during his first year, a number of new missions were opened. He is the author of many pamphlets and two books.
