City Will Become Self-Insurer Effective July 1

In order to save substantial funds over a period of years, the city commission Monday evening decided that on July 1 of this year the City of Birmingham will begin to carry its own workmen's compensation insurance.

"In recommending this action to the commission, City Manager Donald C. Egbert pointed out that at the present time the city is paying considerably more in insurance company premiums than the amount of benefits derived and medical benefits received amounting to only \$11,069.92," the manager explained to commissioners.

"If the city, during that period, had carried its own compensation insurance program, we would have saved \$7,209.60."

The city's experience from 1940 to 1942 was not tabulated, he said. "From 1942 through 1947, we would have saved an additional \$8,442.07."

Benefits As Required by Law

The new program decided upon Monday night will require the city to establish a "compensation insurance fund" into which the city will pay \$2,000 a year until a total of \$18,000 is reached. The fund will be administered by the city.

The City Commission of the City of Birmingham will meet Monday, May 18, 1948, at 7 P. M. in the Council Room in the Municipal Building to consider any objection to the formation of certain improvements on the West side of East from Cole to Young.
