Metamora Hunt to Hold Show at Club Sept. 4, 5

The Metamora Hunt will hold its Metamora hunter and breeder show on Wednesday, Sept. 4 and 5 at the Metamora Hunt Club. The show will be judged by W. Brock Fuller of Milwaukee, Wis.

The show will consist of various divisions, one of which is the confirmation division which includes model hunters shown in hand; hunters under saddle; light weight hunters; middle and heavy weight hunters; qualified hunters (open to horses of any weight) who have been regularly hunted for more than one season with a recognized pack of hounds; ladies' hunters; Michigan bred hunters who will compete for the William Clark Memorial Trophy; pairs of hunters abreast; teams of three hunters; hunter sweepstakes and hunter championship.

Working Hunter

Another division of the show will be the working hunter in which the judge picks the horses most agreeable to hounds and in which the main consideration is even hunting pace, manners, way of going and style of jumping. Confirmation in this division is not to be considered and there will be a light weight class; heavy and middle weight; qualified hunter; ladies' working hunter; solitary hunter sweepstakes and working hunter championship.

There is also scheduled a green hunter division which is open to three and four year olds suitable to become hunters and also open to the green hunter who has not been hunted for more than one season and who has not won a first ribbon in a hunter division except in suitable classes prior to Jan. 1 of the current year. The classes will include the novice young hunter which is open to horses who have not won three first ribbons up to the date of the closing of entries.
