

Will Need More Cash Now to Buy Certain Items

WASHINGTON—It'll be cash on the barrelhead for that new washing machine . . . or at least a good big chunk of cash as a down payment.

For at President Truman's request, Congress restored the Federal restrictions on credit buying until June 30, 1949. These credit

curbs, inaugurated during the war and carried on in modified form until November 1, 1947, will go into effect September 20.

The Federal Reserve Board has the say-so about what will and what won't be controlled. Right now they plan to curb credit buying on most "durable goods."

Affects Refrigerators, Too

The curbing will mean one-third down payment and only 15-18 months to pay on items from \$50 to \$5,000.

The "one-third down and 15 months to pay" regulation will affect refrigerators, stoves, fur coats, and automobile accessories. The curb on furniture will not be so strict . . . one-fifth down and 15 months to pay.

Jewelry buying will not be controlled, so the singing commercials "walk in with a dollar, and out with a watch" will not have been abolished.

Not True Anymore

But the "easy credit term" advertisements on automobiles will not be true, anymore. Most automobiles dealers allow customers 24 months or more to pay.

The war-time controls of charge accounts will not be reinstated, Thurston predicted.

For Mr. and Mrs. America who can't afford to pay one-fifth down on new furniture, here's a solution. Have the old sofa and chairs recovered, and the dining room furniture refinished. There's no curb on stringing out payments for household improvements.

On Way to Berlin, Dr. Hannah Visits 'Pat' Van Wagoner

MUNICH, Germany—Dr. John A. Hannah, president of Michigan State College at East Lansing, has come to Europe for six weeks at the invitation of the Education and Cultural Relations Division of the American Military Government in Berlin.

En route to Berlin, Dr. Hannah called on Munich for the purpose of seeing his old friend Murray D. Van Wagoner, former Michigan legislator, who is now in the office of the Military Government for Bavaria.

Dr. Hannah's visit is of two-fold importance to Americans working to help Western Germany back on her economic and spiritual feet. Military Government agriculture leaders are seeking his advice on setting up an improved agricultural extension service for the German farmer.

Just before coming to Germany, Dr. Hannah served as chairman of a commission which thoroughly surveyed the whole problem in the United States. The report of this commission of five presidents from Land Grant colleges and five Department of Agriculture representatives will be published early in September.

Commented Dr. Hannah, "In America the extension service is so well organized that the results of one day's research is transmitted to the farmers next day. And the farmers' problems can be taken quickly and directly to a nearby laboratory. Such a service would greatly benefit the German farmer."

Of Special Interest

Dr. Hannah's experience in new innovations in college curricula at Michigan State is also of special interest to Military Government officials.

That education's primary responsibility is to fit a person for good citizenship, and that each person is entitled to equal educational opportunity in spite of accident of birth, that is the Doctor's two axioms in his direction of Michigan State College.

To these ends, all his 15,000 students must take certain basic courses in citizenship during their first two years. These courses are in addition to a student's major subject, whether that be teacher training, agricultural engineering, science, home economics, or any of the other 20 or more subjects offered by the university.

Sees Up His Ideas

Dr. Hannah summed up his ideas by saying, "To be a good citizen a person must have the ability to think. This ability must be based on a core of education and information common to all."

Flying to Berlin, and conferences with the Deputy Military Governor, General George Hays, and other officials is the Doctor's schedule for next week. He will be on hand in East Lansing for the opening of the fall college semester, but will probably return to Germany in the near future for further conferences.
