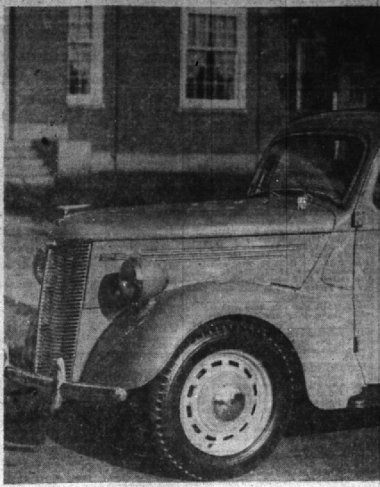

ORDINANCE NO. 375

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 236 of the City of Birmingham being an Ordinance Relating to the Department of Water and Sewerage Department by amending Section 5 (b) of said Ordinance and to repeal Ordinance No. 222 of the City of Birmingham and all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

SECTION FIVE—APPLICATION FOR SERVICE CONNECTION

Any person desiring to connect with the City of Birmingham sewer or water lines shall file an application with the City Engineer and pay the fee for same in accordance with following schedule:

The charges for sewer and water service as specified herein shall apply from March 15th to November 30th inclusive of each year, and during the period of December 1st to March 15th inclusive of each year, there shall be added to the above charges an amount equal to the amount of \$15.00 for the service in a street and \$10.00 for the service in an alley or easement.

The charges as listed shall provide, where possible, a sewer with a depth of 7 feet below the grade at the property line. Where the applicant desires a sewer of greater depth and it is possible to provide same an additional fee shall be paid to compensate the city for the additional cost of providing such additional depth.

The fees charged herein for water service and/or sewer service shall be full payment for the connection to the property line and in the case of water service shall include stop and stop box at said property line.

The Department may require the owner to provide the extension of the service to the building prior to the installation of the service by the Department.

The Department shall leave a stop box for installation by the plumber in those cases where the extension of service to the building is not installed prior to installation by the City of the service from the street to the property line. It shall be the responsibility of the plumber to properly maintain said stop box.

The extension of these services from the property line to the building shall be in accordance with the specifications set forth herein and shall be installed by a licensed plumber, registered as such with the City and setting for the applicant. Such service shall not be installed until a permit for same has been issued by the City and the fee for such permit shall be \$25.00 for water service and \$40.00 for sewer service. Sewer service may be installed by a licensed drain layer.

The water and sewer service from the property line to the building shall be inspected and approved by the City Inspector prior to covering same.

The water and sewer service are not provided hereby representing an additional inspection or inspection, there shall be an additional charge of \$2.00 for each inch of service from the property line to the building.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication, following the passage thereof.
