Western Michigan Football Letters Won by Dunn Boys

KALAMAZOO, Mich., Dec. 8.—The football season is done and again the Dunn boys of Birmingham, Mich., winning letters with the Western Michigan College football team, which finished the season in a tie with the University of Cincinnati for second place, and defeated in the loop only by Miami, 34-28, the champion.

Dick and George are the sons of Mr. and Mrs. John F. Dunn, 1551 Bates, Birmingham. Dick is a senior in college and George is a junior. Dick is 22 years of age, 6 feet 1 inch in height and weighs 195. George is 24 years old, 5 feet 3 inches and weighs 180.

Is Safety Man

Dick Dunn played an end position again for the Broncos, being used heavily in the defensive phase of the Bronco, although he was doing considerable service offensively in Western Michigan's near two team system with the 7 formation.

George Dunn was the defensive quarterback and did a great job in defensive quarters. Dick was a safety man. He was a fine man in returning punts and taking team interceptions and he ended the season in the 40-7 win over Ohio University by taking interception 49 yards for the final touchdown of the game.

George was graduated at Grand Blain high school where he played end, and Dick at the University of Baldwin High, Birmingham. He also played end in high school.

BIRMINGHAM VETERANS NEWS

The Navy Flight Nurse training course has just been reopened. It has been announced by Lt. Lavinia Nyhms, US Navy, in charge of nurse procurement at the Detroit Office of Naval Officer Procurement.

The course is open to all regular Navy nurses under 30 years of age. The training, given in conjunction with the Air Force at the school of Aviation Medicine, Randolph Field, Tex., consists of nine weeks of theoretical and practical training, followed by a three months probationary period leads to the Flight Nurse designation.

The probationary period will be served in the Navy Fleet Logistics supporting wing and routes of the Military Air Transport service Air Evacuation Squadron.

Reserve Nurse Corps members who have been Flight Nurses may be assigned to this branch of the service with a return to active duty.

Both Regular Navy and Naval Reserve Commissions are available to Registered Nurses between the ages of 21 and 40.

Veterans Administration reminds World War II veterans taking on-job training under the G.I. Bill and their employers that individual monthly reports of progress must be submitted to the VA or the veteran will lose his subsistence allowance.

VA said on-job training reports for the month of November were due December 1. Subsidence payments will be suspended in all cases where these reports are not received by December 10.

Veterans who have been dropped from subsistence rolls when their monthly reports of progress failed to reach Veterans Administration in time, will be restored to the rolls as readily as the reports are received within the required time limit, VA announced.

The progress reports must be received by VA within 60 days of the first delinquency. In cases where reports are received after 60 days, veterans will lose subsistence for the delinquent period.

VA said on-job trainees under the G.I. Bill total approximately 19,000 in Michigan.

Selective Service deferment for men 17 and 18 years of age who enlist in the Michigan National Guard has been authorized by Governor Kim Sigler in order that the Michigan National Guard may discharge its responsibility to the security of the nation.

Lifting of all recruiting ceilings on army and air units of the National Guard last week by the National Guard Bureau Washington prompted issuance of the proclamation to insure adequate strength for Michigan. Recruiting will be continued by National Guard units until their recruiting authority is withdrawn. New ceilings are imposed by the National Guard Bureau. The Guard reaches 36,000 authorized for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1949.

Expansion of the Michigan National Guard has been a virtual standstill since passage of the Selective Service Act June 24, 1948. Under the provisions of that act only certain veterans and men outside the draft age were available as potential recruits. Under the terms of the Governor's proclamation just issued, men who enlist in an organized unit of the National Guard prior to attaining the age of 18 years and six months shall be deferred from the draft so long as they continue to serve satisfactorily in the National Guard.

Currently the Michigan National Guard has a strength of 8,855 officers and men. More than 1,000 additional recruits will be required to bring units now organized up to authorized strength.
