**Extend Deadline  
 for CH Classes**

Registration for adult education classes at the Community House has been extended one week and the first series of ten week courses for 1948 will begin on Jan. 19. Miss Amy Wild, recreation director for the Community House, announces.  
 The number of subjects on the adult education program is now 14 and 298 people were registered in the last ten weeks study groups. Newly added is a series of ten lectures called "Introduction to the Arts," given by five members of the staff of the Detroit Institute of Art. Also added are courses in French or Spanish, speech instruction, painting and sketching, knitting, slip cover making, bridge, crafting for students of senior and junior high schools and Saturday morning ceramics classes for children.  
 Subjects which will be resumed for beginners and advanced students include ceramics, silver work, millinery, clothing, hooked rug making and social dancing.
