Local Man Director in Company Which Will Process Radioactive Isotopes

DETROIT—A company to manufacture isotopes for recording radioactivity and to process radioactive isotopes to be obtained from the government uranium pile at Oak Ridge has been incorporated here. Called Radioactive Products, Inc., it is believed to be the first company organized in Michigan and one of the first in the country. Public financing is planned in the near future.

Consumers Power Can't Lift Ban

Consumers Power Company will be unable to connect any additional gas house-heating or other space-heating customers for at least two or three years, division manager David L. Brown said today.

Mr. Brown said many inquiries about gas house-heating had been received from people who apparently were frustrated as ordered by the Michigan Public Service Commission last week. The Commission granted Consumers authority to pass along to its larger gas consumers part of the extra expense involved in obtaining special emergency supplies of gas to protect gas service next winter. It announced that it would not authorize the company at this time to discontinue entirely the connecting of customers who use gas for other purposes than house-heating or space-heating. Consumers earlier had suggested that it might become necessary to ban new customers of all kinds.

Trailers and houseboats do not qualify as homes under the loan guarantees of the G. I. Bill. Veterans Administration branch office officials in Columbus, O., reiterated today.

Replying to numerous inquiries, VA officials said trailers and houseboats, although frequently used as dwellings, are not "homes" within the meaning of the G. I. Bill and are ineligible for loan guaranty.

Four specific benefits become available upon the death of a veteran of any war, it was pointed out today by Veterans Administration branch office officials in Columbus, O.

Applications for any one of the four benefits may be procured from any VA office, from service organizations and from chapters of the American Red Cross. Benefits are available only when the veteran has been discharged under conditions other than dishonorable.
