Mills Pharmacy Has Anniversary

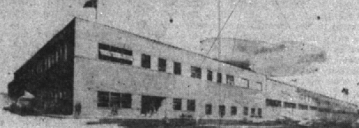

The new Greyhound maintenance garage, opened Monday in Detroit, is the largest establishment of its kind in the country. Capable of caring for the fleet of 600 coaches in the Great Lakes Greyhound Lines, the huge building occupies two city blocks.

The country's largest bus maintenance garage was opened in Detroit Monday by the Great Lakes Greyhound Lines. The huge two-story building will house the garage, offices and dormitories for the drivers and will cover two city blocks being bounded by Lafayette, 15th, Fort and 17th streets.

The mayor of Detroit, Eugene Van Antwerp, was present to open the ceremonies and were many Greyhound officials and personnel. Facilities will be adequate to keep the company's 600 coaches in constant repair, from major rebuilding jobs to retouching painted surfaces and washing the coaches. The first floor, devoted entirely to repairs, refueling, painting, storage of coaches and the like will occupy 184,788 square feet.

The service will be maintained by a staff of 27 highly trained servicemen whose job will be to keep all coaches in excellent condition and speed and improve maintenance operations.

The garage houses two automatic washers, which are capable of completely washing one of the larger highway buses in 40 seconds. Kemtec controlled fuel and lubricating pumps will keep them ready for the highway at a moment's notice.

Coaches brought in will be washed and swept inside and with the motor checked along with the rest of the vehicle.

The rest rooms for drivers provide a maximum of comfort, with sleeping quarters for men who are here on over-night stops. They are all air conditioned and sound proof.

Two way radio will keep the dispatcher in constant touch with every coach on the road, and meet up replacements in the case of breakdowns. Drivers on long runs will be informed at 16 weather conditions which they are to encounter on their trips as well as road conditions.

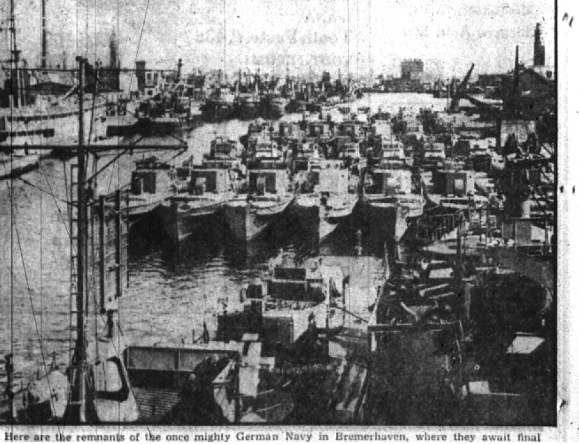

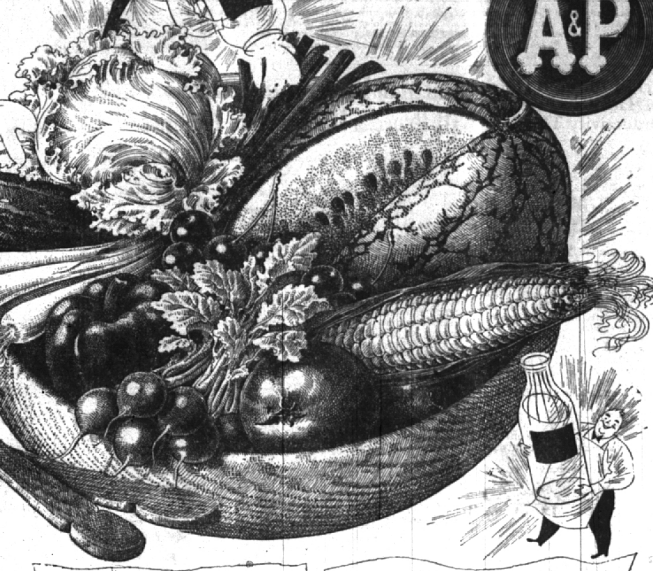


Here are the remnants of the once mighty German Navy in Bremerhaven, where they await final disposal.
