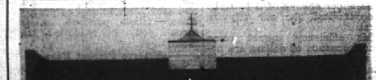
DO YOU KNOW WHAT THESE SYMBOLS STAND FOR?

Authority on Plastics To Address Kiwanians

"The Modern Approach to Plastics in Our World Today" will be the topic of W. J. Connelly when he speaks before members of the Kiwanis Club at the Community House July 27. Connelly

is a well-known authority on plastics, and his talks with visual presentations which will show the many fields in which plastics are now being used. The Bunyon bag, made of Vinylite plastic, and widely used in the treatment of burns will be among the more important items to be shown. Another which came into an important place during the war years is a still which converts salt water into clear, pure drinking water through the influence of the sun's rays. The Vinylite transcription-discs, so thin that one can read through them and a new hoylecomb material, said to be the strongest weight strength-ratio of any structural material, along with Bakelite polystyrene, which varies in use from electrical insulation to providing parts for a chromatic harmonica will also be shown by Connelly.

Bakelite polystyrene is one of the better-known plastics, as far as the general public is concerned, since it is used for food packaging and many other similar uses. A densified wood has a wide variety of uses, will also be among the products he will show. Bakelite phenolic, the plastic molding material, which is used to make minute screws, a few millimeters in width as well as housings for modern radio phonograph combinations will also take its place in the exhibit, along with the Vinylite recordings for the blind, in which whole books are transcribed.

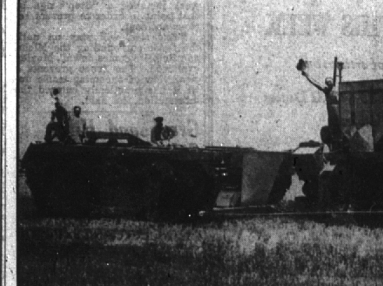

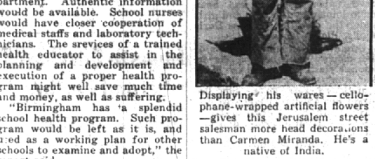

Add to Health Benefits

Existing public health personnel would be transferred to the one over-all Southern Oakland department. It has been suggested that the county health department itself be transferred to the Birmingham office, as little time as possible be lost in getting it under way.

In health education, alone, the city would stand to benefit greatly through the workings of the department. Authentic information would be available. School nurses would have close cooperation of medical staffs and laboratory technicians. The services of a trained health educator to assist in the planning and development and execution of a proper health program might save much time and money, as well as suffering.

"Birmingham has a splendid school health program. Such program would be left as it is and used as a working plan for other schools to examine and adopt," the report said.

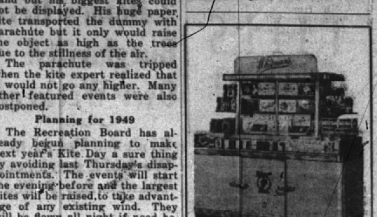
Asparagus beds started from seed will begin producing very almost as soon as a bed started from roots. A bed in rich, deep soil will last a lifetime.
