Christian Science
Lesson Sermon for
Sunday, Aug. 1

"Love" will be the subject of the Lesson-Sermon in all Christian Science churches throughout the world on Sunday, August 1.

The Golden Text (1 John 4:16) is: "We have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him."

Among the Bible citations in this passage (1 John 4:7, 8): "Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love."

Correlative passages to be read from the Christian Science textbook, "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy, include the following (p.312): "People go into ecstasies over the sense of a corporal Jehovah, though with scarcely a spark of love in their hearts; yet God is Love, and without Love, God, immortality cannot appear. Mortals believe in a finite personal God; while God is infinite Love, which must be unlimited."

Dr. Hartman A. Lichtwardt to Preach at First Presbyterian Church

The First Presbyterian Church has announced that Dr. Hartman A. Lichtwardt will serve in place of Dr. W. Glen Harris while the latter is abroad for the remainder of the summer.

Dr. Lichtwardt was born and educated in Detroit where he was through Russia and Poland just before the invasion of the latter country. He managed to leave Germany shortly before her borders were closed. When the war started, he went back to Iran.

Unable to return to Iran at present, the Lichtwardts are now living in Detroit where he was once on the surgical staff of the Henry Ford Hospital. Dr. Lichtwardt is now the medical director of Women's Hospital in Detroit.

He is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a member of the Wayne County Medical Society and a fellow of the American Medical Association. Greatly interested in world affairs, he was, in the past, president of the Foreign Policy Association of Detroit and chairman of the executive board of the World Study Council. He is now an active member of the Economic Club, the Torch Club and is on the board of the Methodist Children's Village.
