

65 From Cranbrook Enroll In Colleges

Of the 67 graduates of Cranbrook School 65 have been admitted to colleges, it was announced today by W. Brooke Stabler, headmaster of Cranbrook School. The remaining two will take a post-graduate year in secondary school before entering college.

About 60 per cent of this number will attend college in the east, fifteen of whom will be at Harvard, Princeton or Yale. The remaining 40 per cent will continue their studies in the middle or far West, 11 at Michigan or Michigan State.

Seven of these seniors, all of whom received scholarship aid at Cranbrook because of financial need, won generous scholarships in the colleges of their choice. Harvard granted two scholarships and Cornell, Dartmouth, Duke, Yale and the University of Pennsylvania, one each.
