Youthful Railroad President from Bloomfield Hills Dedicates Lakeshore Route

The Tispico Lakeshore Railroad, with general offices at Thornlea, Bloomfield Hills, was officially dedicated a few days ago when Stephen F. Booth, 23, drove the golden spike into one of the railroad ties.

The road is not in Bloomfield Hills, however. It is along the west shore of Tispico Lake, just south of Fenton, where Steve's father, Henry S. Booth, has a summer cottage.

HOUSING & KENNELING During the greater part of the year typical outdoor kennels can be used for dogs. In the winter a floor and plenty of bedding such as straw or cedar shavings is desirable.

Kennels in buildings should be well ventilated and free from draughts. Floors and walls should be of hardwood, tile or concrete. In all cases they should be so constructed as to be easily cleaned and disinfected.

Kennels can be built in many ways: flat roofed, peaked roofed, two-story or round. The type of construction is immaterial so far as the finished product affords good protection, is handy to clean and serves its purpose.
