

To the qualified Electors:

Notice is hereby given that an election will be held in the City of Bloomfield Hills, in the County of Oakland and State of Michigan, on Monday, April 5, 1948, in the Municipal Building on East Long Lake Road for the purpose of electing the following officers:

Two City Commissioners and One Constable And to vote on the following propositions:

A. Shall the limitation on the total amount of taxes which may be assessed each year against property in the County of Oakland, State of Michigan, for all purposes except taxes for the payment of interest and principal on obligations incurred prior to December 8. 1932, be increased as provided in Section 21, Article X, of the Constitution of Michigan, for a period of two (2) years from 1948 to 1949, both inclusive, by one fifth (1/5) of one per cent (\$2.00 per \$1000.00) of the assessed valuation, as equalized, to permit the levying of a two (2) mill tax for the purpose of altering the present Infirmary, constructing a Hospital addition thereto, and equipping the same?

B. Shall a tax of two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1000.00) be levied on all of the assessable property in the County of Oakland, State of Michigan, in the years 1948 and 1949, both inclusive, for the purpose of altering the present Infirmary, constructing a Hospital addition thereto, and equipping the same?

The Polls of said election will be open at 7 o'clock A. M. and will remain open until 8 o'clock P. M. of said day of election.
