BIRMINGHAM VETERANEWS

Veterans pursuing full-time courses in schools and colleges who are entitled to increase subsistence rates by reason of dependency have until July 1, to submit proof for retroactive payments.

If veterans submit evidence by July 1, they will receive retroactive payments at the new rates back to April 1. Evidence received after that date will be effective the day of receipt.

New rates now in effect allow veterans with one dependent the sum of \$105 a month and \$120 for those with more than one dependent. Single veterans receive \$75. Eligible veterans now in school who are entitled to \$75 or \$105 do not have to apply because Veterans Administration offices have the information required to increase automatically.

Proof of additional dependency for the new increase consist of photostats or certified copies of birth in the case of dependent children and evidence of actual dependency in the case of dependent parents.

Certificate of eligibility issued to a veteran upon his entrance into job-training or school study under the G. I. Bill loses its validity if the veteran discontinues his training, according to Veterans Administration Branch Office officials in Columbia.

The trainee who has discontinued his training and later desires to resume his studies under the G. I. Bill must obtain a supplemental certificate of eligibility from VA.

Application for the supplemental certificate may be made through any VA office.

Veterans who lose subsistence, compensation or pension checks should notify immediately the appropriate Veterans Administration regional office.

A veteran losing such a check should write a letter giving his full name and address, his claim number and the date and amount of the check. He also should state for which type of benefit the check was issued and the circumstances surrounding its loss.

On being notified of the check's loss, VA determines whether it has been found and returned to the U. S. Treasury. If so, the check will be re-issued to the veteran. If not, VA will request the Treasury to stop payment and take necessary steps to reimburse the veteran.

A veteran who finds his check after reporting its loss should notify VA and hold the check until he has been advised by the Treasury that action to stop payment has been withdrawn.

The Nation's memorial to World War II dead—the Gold Star and Button—will be ready for distribution after June 1, 1948, to the next of kin of men and women of all the armed services who died for their country at home and abroad.

The authority for this recognition came in Public Law No. 306, enacted by the 80th Congress, which set up an appropriate designation of widows, parents, and certain other members of the families of those who died in the service of their country between December 7, 1941 and August 11, 1947, the period established by the legislation.

The Gold Star Without Cost of a Gold Star on a purple circular background, bordered in gold and surrounded by gold laurel leaves. On the reverse is the inscription, "United States of America, Act of Congress, 1947", with space for the engraving of the initials of the recipient.

The Gold Star Buttons to be furnished, without cost, to the widowed or widower and to each of the parents of a deceased member of the Armed Forces who lost his life while on active military service between December 7, 1941 and August 11, 1947, both dates inclusive.

The term "parents" includes mother, father, stepmother, stepfather, mother through adoption and father through adoption. One Gold Star button will be furnished at cost price to each child, stepchild, brother, sister, half brother, and half sister of a deceased member of the armed forces if the death fell within the dates fixed.

How to Apply

Next of kin of deceased Army and Air Force personnel may submit applications to The Adjutant General, United States Army, Washington 25, D. C. Application forms will be available about June 1, 1948, and may be obtained from any Army or Air Force installation, any nationally recognized veterans organization, or The Adjutant General.

Navy, Coast Guard and Marine applications should go to the Chief Bureau of Naval Personnel, Navy Department, Washington, D. C. and they likewise may be procured from Naval installations or veterans organizations, or from the Bureau of Naval Personnel.

Limited initial token presentations of the Gold Star Buttons will be held throughout the United States and some possessions on Memorial Day.
