The results of the May 12 game: East and West—Mr. and Mrs. John A. Staus; Mr. and Mrs. A. L. Bogie, second. North and South: Mrs. Fletcher Kenton and Mrs. Malcolm Dugins, first; Myrtle Rummel and Jim Gray, second.

Bob Voss is credited with an assist in bringing an old bridge chestnut known as the "Mississippi heart hand". The story runs something like this:

The place: The main lounge of the "City of Memphis" as it moves away from the levee and out into the channel. The whistle is sounding, the engines are pounding, and old mah rivers is rolling along. The time: the middle twenties—shortly after auction became contract in a nationwide resurgence of interest in the game.

In one corner of the lounge, behind a potted magnolia tree a bridge game is in progress. Two mustachioed lovers of the river are diligently losing rubber after a rubber to a pair of unweaned lambs—at a meager ten cents a point. Finally, the psychological moment arrives. Wolfe Number One suggests that the stakes be increased to one dollar a point. Lamb Number One and Two enthusiastically agree. Meanwhile, Wolfe Number Two, by sleight of hand, slips in the "old" deck. Lamb Number One deals and picks up this hand:

S-A-K-Q  
H-K-J-9  
D-A-K-Q-J  
C-A-K-Q

"Six no trump" he announces, mentally counting his profits. "Seven hearts," growls Wolfe Number Two, in the next position. "Pass."

"Double!" shouts Lamb Number One. "Redouble," hisses Wolfe Number Two.

The opening lead is a small spade. Dummy goes down. Here is the complete deal.

NORTH  
H-8-5-4-3-2  
C-10-9-8-7-6-5-4  
WEST  
S-3-2 S-A-K-Q  
D-10-9-8-7-6-5-4 H-K-J-9  
C-3-2 D-A-K-Q-J  
C-A-K-Q

SOUTH  
S-10-9-8-7-6-5-4  
H-A-Q-10-9-8-7-6-5-4

The opening lead is ruffed in dummy. A club is then led and ruffed in the closed hand. A second spade is ruffed in dummy. The heart is led and finessed in the closed hand. A third spade ruff establishes the spade suit. Another heart lead is finessed. The heart ace then takes out East's last trump and South spreads his cards.
