Citizens Must Help With Planning If City Is to Progress, Mayor Declares

Only through a broad citizen participation in community affairs, as expressed to and through the newly created 9-man city plan commission, can Birmingham and the surrounding area progress.

This opinion came this week from Mayor Milton F. Mallender in a statement elaborating on a new plan of the city's future.

"Since 1933, when we adopted our charter, the city has been operating under the old village planning ordinance," Mallender explained. "In the meantime, the state has given cities newer, more up-to-date planning powers. Several members of the old plan commission have expressed to me their feeling that they have been putting in a great deal of time and effort, but did not have much legal authority."

A Modern Footing To place the city planning on a modern footing, the city commission felt it was time to incorporate recent state powers in a new plan ordinance and a new plan commission, the mayor pointed out.

"I sincerely hope this new plan group will act as a directing influence for the city commission. And I hope it can enlist the aid of citizens in serving on various committees," the mayor said. "The city is growing rapidly, and only on a broad citizen participation basis can the city progress."

In naming the nine new members to the plan commission, Mallender said he wanted six members to represent various local groups: board of education (A. W. Seaborn), mercantile (Harry O. Machus), real estate board (Elliott S. Kinney), women's organizations (Mrs. Peter B. Leamon), professional (Dr. Robert Maton), and architectural (Edward Bissell).

"Since city affairs concern the surrounding area, and vice versa, I also named representatives of two townships—Dr. Mason (Bloomfield) and Harold F. Klein (Troy)," Mallender continued.

Emmons Residents Petition City for Lesser Improvement

Upon petition by 100 per cent of the residents of Emmons street, between Woodward and Torrey, that their street improvement program be written down because of excessive financial burdens thus imposed, the city commission decided to assess that street for only grading and graveling.

It was last week that commissioners approved the street improvement to include curb, gutters and hard surfacing as well.

However, representative property owners pointed out Monday night that this complete improvement imposed too heavy a financial burden on the residents, and asked that they be given some improvement more in line with their present pocketbooks.

The commission agreed that the least it could do to get them off the muddy street which periodically batters them, was give them grading and gravel. This reduced the average assessment from \$228 to \$176.
