Work has been received of the death of Mr. Harry Ralph Hunt of San Bernardino, Calif., on Wednesday, Aug. 25. He was the son of the late Charles G. and Ada Covert Hunt who were former Bloomfield Township residents. He was born on April 12, 1878, at Quanton and Lakser roads in Bloomfield Hills and attended the Birmingham High school. He was a Spanish American War veteran and served in the Philippines.
