My partner opened the bidding third-hand with one heart. East over-called with one spade and I bid two clubs. North bid three hearts and I bid three no-trump.

West opened the diamond queen. I let dummy's king hold this trick, of course. Then I led over to the heart ace and received the sad news on the heart suit. Things looked pretty bad for our side.

I thought it over for quite a while. I counted entries and re-entries and considered the timing. Finally I concluded that my one chance to make the contract was to knock out the ace and king of spades immediately. Of course, the opponents would (or should) continue the diamond suit. But if diamonds broke four-four I was safe.

So I led the spade ten and the whole thing worked out. I got home with three spades, three hearts, two diamonds, and one club.

When the score sheet was unfolded we found we had a top score. All other north-south teams had played it in four hearts, down one. Then our opponents called the law: It was plain fraud for me to bid no-trump with a spade stopper! It was deceitful for me not to bid four hearts when I had second round trump support, and my partner

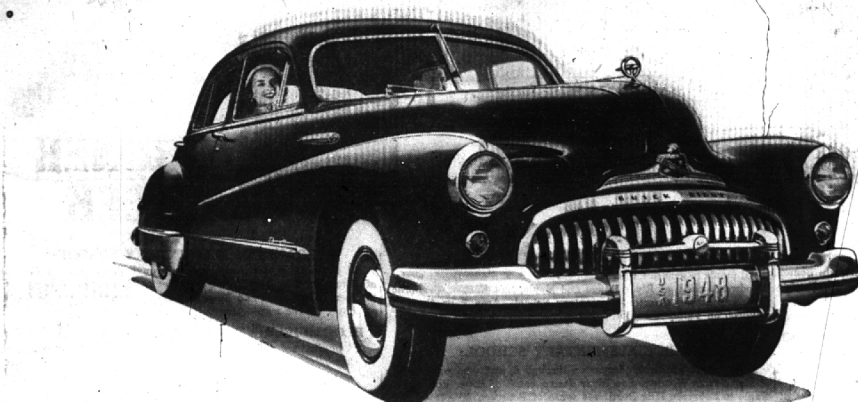
