Many Birmingham Scouts and Cubs are planning to attend the exhibit being held in Detroit's Convention Hall this Thursday, Friday and Saturday. According to Scout executives, the exhibit will be the world's largest and most spectacular show of its kind ever held. There are over 35,000 registered participants from the Detroit area counties.

Among the exhibits, which will occupy the entire Convention Hall, will be the Sea Scout launch, a full-sized wind tunnel and the Explorer Scouts who will saddle their mountain burro in preparation for Philmont, their Rocky Mountain ranch in New Mexico. Other Scouts will present authentic Indian dances, in gorgeous hand-made tribal costumes.

The Hall will be open from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Thursday and Friday and from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Saturday, when tickets may be purchased at the box office. Amos Sheffield, chief Scout Area executive, said the ticket price had been set to merely cover the cost of the display and that it is in no way a money-making proposition.

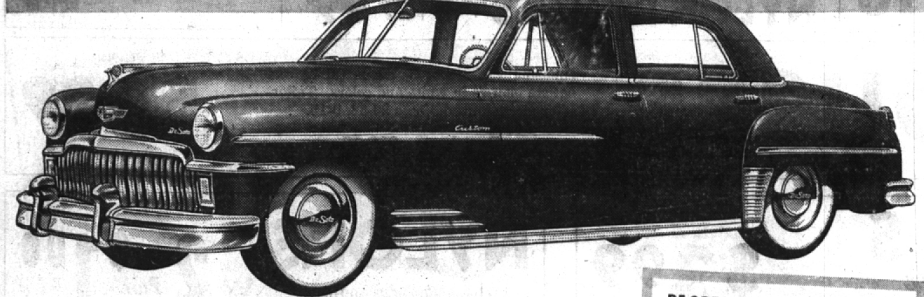

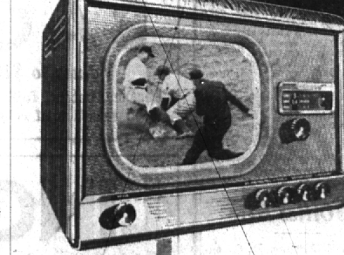
