New Fire Hall
The fire department held open house Wednesday evening Aug. 10, at its new fire hall at 20000 West Ten Mile road. Township officials attended as well as volunteer firemen and their families from this section.
The new building changes the insurance rate for residents in the district. Property owners must reside within 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant and be within three miles of the fire station to receive the new rate, however. The district covered is bounded on the northeast by Twelve Mile and Greenfield, west to Evergreen, south to Eleven mile, west to within a quarter of a mile of Lahser, south to Eight Mile, east to Greenfield and north to Twelve Mile road.

Dog Ordinance
Southfield township board passed a dog ordinance at its meeting Wednesday, Aug. 10, in the town hall on Berg road.
The ordinance which regulates ownership of dogs, issuing of licenses, operation of a dog pound and collection of fees is based on provision of a new act passed this year. These functions were formerly executed by the county.
